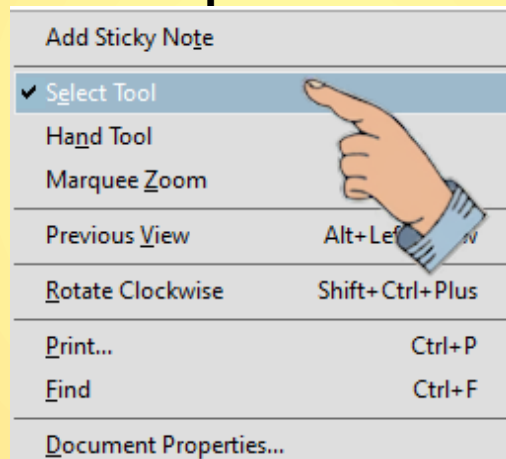


# Sample Images for Gimp Fundamentals

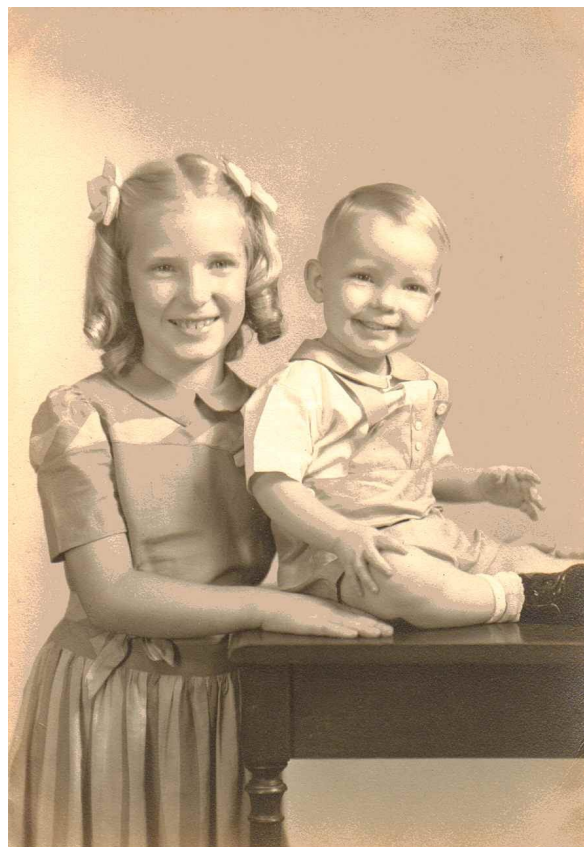
**Figure 12, Family 6**

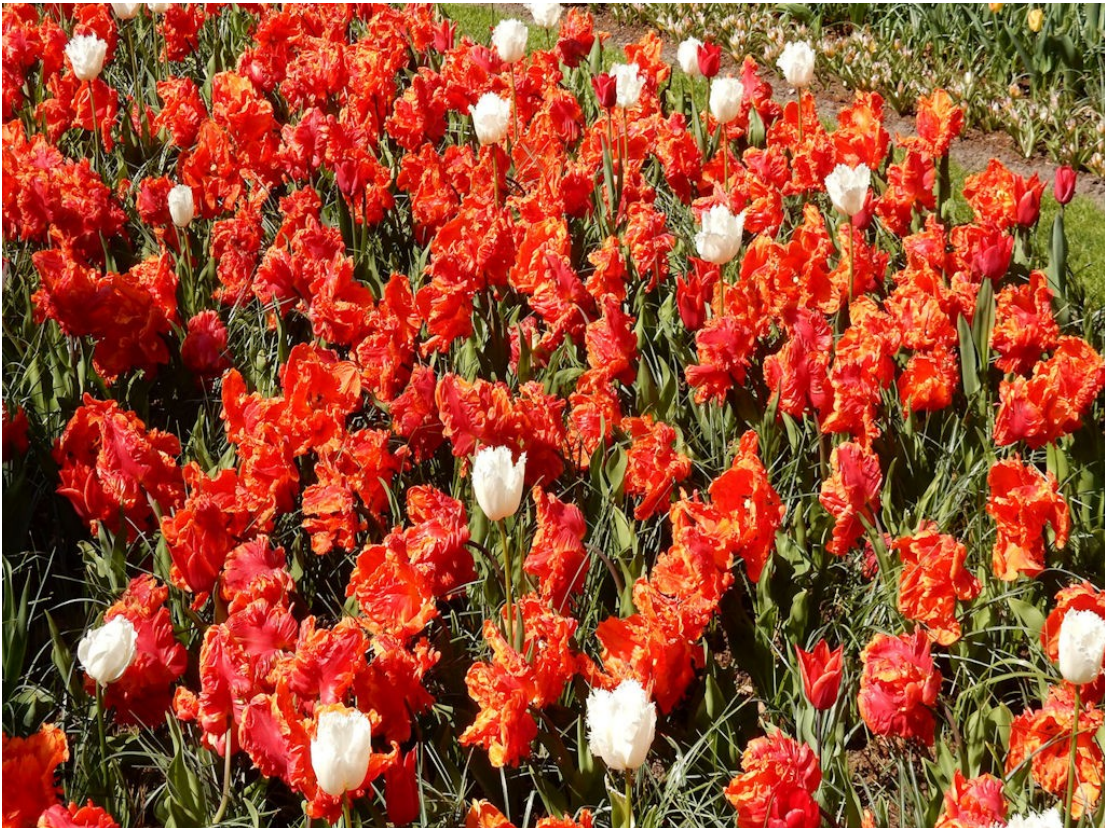


**Figure 17, Scan 2**
